The Board of Directors and volunteers were very busy in 2017 managing projects throughout the community. Our community has some age on it and we are in the process of updating and replacing assets around the community. Areas may become restricted and impact your ability to access while work is being completed. We will do our best to notify everyone in advance and on our progress.

Community Hot Topics in 2017:

- The Pool and Clubhouse parking lots were repaved in 2017 after years of wear and neglect.

- The Crossroads entrance was updated and refreshed.
- We can't forget about the beavers. Flooding of community and neighbors' properties were the result of six beaver dams on Caldwell Creek. The dams have been opened thanks to volunteers, and trappers have removed the beavers for now. Monitoring and creek cleanup will continue in 2018 with the help of volunteers.

LANDSCAPE COMMITTEE

Happy New Year.

I hope everyone had a nice holiday season. There certainly is a Winter chill in the air, however, Spring is just around the corner. It is time to start thinking about what your yard needs to "wake up." Mid-February is the best time to inspect your shrubs and selectively prune knock-out roses and crepe myrtles. If you are not sure how, I suggest searching online for the proper technique. There are plenty of great websites, but try to focus on those that refer to Zone 7 and the NC region.

Applying a pre-emergent crabgrass preventer such as Scotts Halts is recommended and can be applied around mid-February. Make sure you give your yard a good raking first to remove dead grass, twigs, etc., to allow the fertilizer to create a barrier to work more efficiently.

Our *Yard Of The Month* program will start again in May. A \$25 gift card to Lowes Home Improvement Center will be given to the homeowner whose yard stands out the most. Please refer to our Porter's Landing website for the criteria in which the reward is based on.

One of the goals of the Landscape Committee for 2018 is to enhance the appearance of our high-visibility areas of our community. We will continue planting near the pool area entrance and along the Baystone walkway to the pool parking lot. If you find that you have plants or shrubs that you no longer want in your landscape, please contact myself or any member of the Committee so that we can determine whether we can utilize them in our existing landscape. This will help to accomplish our mission and save on our landscape budget.

We chose a new vendor for the pine needle application throughout the neighborhood. As a result, this saved us money and lessened the burden on our budget.

We recently completed a workday project to remove the beaver dam in the creek behind Crossroads Place. This was necessary to keep the water flowing and to prevent water backup and subsequent flooding. Another workday will be scheduled to remove some fallen trees and debris in the creek. Any residents that own a chainsaw and would be willing to help with this would be greatly appreciated.

If you enjoy gardening and would like to devote some time to the Landscape Committee's endeavors to help beautify Porter's Landing, please contact us. We meet the second Tuesday of every month at The Hangar at 7:00 p.m. Our first meeting of the year is scheduled for February 12th.

There is a non-refundable rental fee required for all rentals of the Clubhouse.

In addition to:

- Clubhouse rental is for current residents ONLY.
- No outside rentals are allowed.
- For parties up to 50 people, there is a \$100.00 refundable deposit.
- For parties larger than 50 people, there is a \$150.00 refundable deposit.
- Refund of the security deposit check is upon the inspector's confirmation that the facility was left in good condition and that the keys were returned.
- Any costs incurred to clean or repair the facility will be deducted from the security deposit.

ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE

The Porter's Landing Architectural Committee is responsible for maintaining and upholding the Covenants and Restrictions of the neighborhood. It is our responsibility to review architectural requests from homeowners who want to "make improvements" to their property (i.e. add a structure of some sort, fence, utility building, screen porch addition, playhouse, etc...)

Forms may be obtained from any Committee member OR on our website at *www.portersland-ing.org*. Simply go to "Committees and Facilities" then "Architectural" and there you can download forms

Guidelines covering home additions are in "The Covenants and Restrictions" section of your homeowner's package you received (and signed) when purchasing your home.

A copy can be found in our section online. Requests require approval before the project begins. Please plan in advance as the approval process can take up to 30 days.
